

Will the Marriage Supper Occur Between Trumpets & Atonement OR Between Atonement & Feast of Tabernacles?

- (1) Revelation 15:8 states that no one is allowed to enter the heavenly temple during the last 7 plagues (and these 7 last plagues begin on the Day of Trumpets and continue until the Day of Atonement).
- (2) If the marriage supper took place between the Day of Trumpets and the Day of Atonement (during the 7 last plagues) we would be rejoicing and celebrating in heaven while millions of people (maybe even some of our very own friends and relatives) are suffering greatly!
- (3) Also, if that were the case, the millennium would really be starting on the 10th or the 11th (and not the 15th). And yet we know that the millennium will begin at the start of the Feast of Tabernacles (which occurs on the 15th and not the 10th or the 11th).
- (4) Also, if Jesus didn't really return to Earth until the day of Atonement then that would mean that the return of Jesus Christ is pictured by the Day of Atonement (and yet we know that it's the Day of Trumpets that pictures the return of Christ to this earth and not the Day of Atonement).
- (5) Also, we would be celebrating and rejoicing *before* Satan is put away (instead of *after* he is put away) since we know that Satan will be put away on the Day of Atonement (the 10th day).
- (6) Revelation 17:14 & 19:19-21 state that Jesus and the *saints* with Him will defeat the Beast power (Rev. 17:14 & 19:19-21), and yet this occurs at the 7th and final plague (Rev. 16:12-21). And the 7th and final plague occurs between the Day of Trumpets and the Day of Atonement, and almost surely immediately before the Day of Atonement begins as Rev. 19:17-21 & 20:1 show that Satan is put away (on the 10th day) *right after* the Beast is defeated. And Rev. 19:1-9 (especially verse 1) shows that the marriage occurs *after* the *defeat* of the Beast.
- (7) So almost surely this is how it should all take place: Jesus will return to the Earth on the Day of Trumpets (the 1st day of the 7th month). At that time the saints who are dead in their graves will be resurrected and rise in the air to meet Him. Immediately thereafter those saints who are alive at that time will also rise in the air. Then Jesus Christ and all the saints will land on the mount of Olives. At this time Jesus will unleash the 1st of the last 7 plagues. And then one-by-one all 7 of the final plagues will be released (with the 7th and final plague ending immediately before the 10th day of the month). Then on the 10th day of the month (the Day of Atonement) Satan is bound up and thrown into prison.

Afterwards Christ and the saints travel to heaven. The marriage supper between Jesus Christ and the saints then takes place in heaven between the 10th and 15th day of the month. Then on the 15th day of the month (at the beginning of the Feast of Tabernacles) Jesus and the saints return to Earth to begin the 1,000-year reign of Jesus Christ on this Earth.

7th Month of Biblical Calendar

1st Day = Day of Trumpets = Jesus Returns & Saints Resurrected

1st Day to 10th Day = Last 7 Plagues

10th Day = Day of Atonement = Satan Bound

10th Day to 15th Day = Marriage Banquet

15th Day = Start of Feast of Tabernacles = Start of Millennium

If the marriage supper takes place before the 11th day, then the millennium would begin on the 11th day (after Satan is bound). But this cannot be correct, because if the millennium reign of Jesus really starts on the 11th day, then God would have made sure that the Feast of Tabernacles started on the 11th day (instead of the 15th day) since the Feast of Tabernacles pictures the millennium. But it doesn't start on the 11th! Instead it starts on the 15th! Therefore the millennium reign of Jesus Christ must start on the 15th (and not the 11th), and this also means that that the marriage supper must take place between the 10th and 15th day of the 7th month!
