

CORRECTION

Prov 15:10 — Harsh *correction* is for him who forsakes the way, and he who hates reproof will die.

Prov 13:18 — Poverty and shame will come to him who disdains *correction*, but he who regards reproof will be honored.

Prov 10:17 — He who keeps instruction is in the way of life, but he who refuses *reproof* goes astray.

Prov 9:7-9 — He who *reproves* a scoffer gets shame for himself, and he who *rebukes* a wicked man gets himself a blemish. Do not *reprove* a scoffer, lest he hate you; *rebuke* a wise man, and he will love you. Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

Prov 6:23 — For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light; *reproofs* of instruction are the way of life.

Prov 5:11-13 — And you mourn at last, when your flesh and your body are consumed, and say: “How I have hated instruction, and my heart despised *reproof*! I have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, nor inclined my ear to those who instructed me!”

Prov 12:1 — Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, but he who hates *reproof* is stupid.

Prov 29:1 — He who is often *reproved*, and hardens his neck, will suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.
